Below is information on Government Assistance/Support provided to all people during country lockdown towards stopping the spread of COVID-19:-

Eastern Cape: Department of Social Development:- In a bid to cushion the blow of hunger dealt to many families during the nation COVID-19 Lockdown, we are offering Social Relief Food Parcels to those in need. Such families are advised to report to their ward Councillors who will then draft a list to be submitted to SASSA, municipality and the department for the delivery of the food parcels. The Joint Operations Committee formed of officials from our department's provincial and district offices, ward Councillors, Community Development Workers, SASSA, Department of Health, disaster management, traffic & SAPS are working tirelessly to ensure speedy interventions in the relief rollout.

This is a National initiative; for other provinces call the national call centre on (0800) 601-011 or Social Grant - +27 878090055. On delivery of food parcel you will require your ID document.

Food Parcels provided: 10kg mielie meal; 5kg rice; 2.5kg sugar; 1kg soya; 1kg salt; 880g peanut butter; 1pkt tea bags; 2 tins bake beans; 2 tins fish; 1bottel sunlight liquid; 1bottel all purpose cleaner; 1pk of 2 bars sunlight washing soap; 2litre oil (It depends on how many family members are in each family).
